

1. The meeting was called to order by President Karen Cunningham at 7 PM.
2. Introductions were made of those present.
3. Secretary, Sean Schrader asked if there were any corrections to the CNC September Minutes. There were none, and Bud Elias made a motion to approve the minutes, and Bill Jonson seconded the minutes.
4. The Treasurer stated that there were minimal changes to both accounts.
5. The Vice-President gave an update regarding a newly formed YouTube Channel that was recently created in order to publicize activities from the Skycrest Neighborhood Association.
6. The President asked those present to respect the rules of the organization, and to remain orderly throughout the meeting. The president encouraged those present to attend an upcoming neighborhoods conference sponsored by the CNC, and the Sierra Club. The topic of the conference will be "Building Better Neighborhoods through Sustainability: A toolkit for Positive Change". She encouraged those present to consider running for an officer's position within the CNC. She reminded those present that this organization serves to educate those throughout our community, about neighborhood-related issues.
7. Former Mayor, and Candidate for Mayor, Frank Hibbard encouraged those present who are candidates running for city-council to wait until January 2nd to put up Campaign Signs, in order to prevent signs being too cluttered throughout the City.
8. Clearwater Police Chief, Daniel Slaughter thanked those present, and the Clearwater community at-large for helping reduce crime in multiple areas throughout Clearwater. He also mentioned that thanks to advances in crime-prevention technology, it has allowed residents to become more aware of crime that is taking place throughout their community. He also mentioned that Sex Crimes throughout Clearwater have gone up, and that in most cases, drugs or alcohol were involved in the crime.

State Senator Ed Hooper asked those present to pay attention to the upcoming State Legislative Session, and ask that they stay proactive, and to ensure that their voice is heard regarding issues that they see are important to them. Representative Chris Latvala was pleased with the large turnout for this meeting, and expressed his interest in hearing comments from those present. Throughout the course of the meeting, Senator Hooper, and Representative Latvala discussed topics such as affordable housing, Jordan's Law, mental health & gun control in relation to mass shootings, Scientology, Home Rule, Animal Welfare, Red Tide, and Plastic Straw/Plastic Bag bans.
