

Membership in CNC

There shall be two categories of CNC membership:

1. Neighborhood (\$40).

A. Neighborhood membership is open to any civic association, homeowner's association or condominium association registered with the city of Clearwater. Each neighborhood member shall appoint one representative, and an alternate; however, the association will have only one vote in CNC affairs.

B. For purposes of these bylaws, a civic association must be a Florida not for-profit corporation that limits membership to residents within specific geographic boundaries and is formed for the benefit of those residents.

C. An association's representative or alternate may stand for election as an officer or director. If elected, the representative or alternate shall no longer be the official representative or alternate of their individual association because they now represent all of the CNC. The association shall be entitled to replace their representative and alternate if one or both of those individuals were elected to office.

2. Associate (\$15). Associate membership is open to any resident of the city of Clearwater. Associate members may take part in CNC activities which are not specifically limited to neighborhood members, including speaking at meetings, and serving on certain committees. Associate members cannot vote or serve as officers or directors.
