- A. Michael Delk**, Planning and Development Director for the City of Clearwater, [Michael.Delk@myclearwater.com](mailto:Michael.Delk@myclearwater.com), spoke to us about transit oriented development, TOD, on behalf of the Urban Land Institute of Tampa Bay. ULI of Tampa Bay is comprised of approximately 250 members and focuses on the responsible use of land in order to create a thriving community. The Tampa Bay area is looking at ways to enhance the proposed High Speed Rail HSR, system that is scheduled to be developed by 2012. Some ideas include Light Rail Systems, Enhanced Busses and Street Cars. Effective TOD can reduce the transportation budget for a U.S. family household from 19% to 9%.
