The City of Clearwater, and other communities, have created groups to educate and seek ways to reduce flood insurance sold through the National Flood Insurance Program NFIP. Premiums under this program are expected to rise as FEMA adjust flood maps. The NFIP is the only flood insurer authorized to cover Fannie-Mae, Freddie-Mac, VA, and Ginnie-Mae conforming loans. Through education and awareness volunteers participating in the PPI/CRS program hope to obtain lower premiums for homeowners impacted by NFIP. THANK YOU KAREN.
